How We Help

1. Financial Assistance:

Education Grants

- › Children from day care to tertiary level including apprenticeships
- › Police legatees who need to re-train to return to the workforce
- › Specialist scholarships for police legatees in leadership, technical studies, secondary and tertiary excellence, sporting excellence and police education and training

Welfare Grants and Special Assistance

- › Special assistance for families in necessitous circumstances
- › Fundraising facilitation for members of the wider police family facing challenging circumstances
- › Funding for driving lessons for police legatees of all ages
- › Trust Fund administration and management

2. Community Engagement
